Interruptible Transportation/Capacity Release Generic

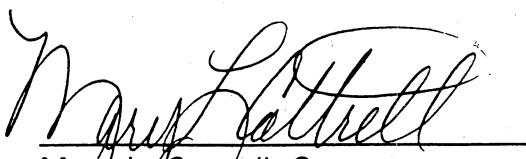
The Department of Public Utilities, on its own motion, is investigating the availability and proper rate for Interruptible Transportation offered by local distribution companies within the Commonwealth, and related issues pertaining to local distribution companies' release of capacity of the interstate pipeline systems.

The Department of Public Utilities ("Department") will conduct a procedural conference on the above-captioned matter at its offices, 12th floor, Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02202 on Thursday, June 23, 1994 at 10:00 A.M. Any person interested in participating in the procedural conference is requested to notify the Hearing Officer no later than June 9, 1994. On or before June 17, 1994, the Department will mail to those individuals who will attend the procedural conference a document which describes (1) the scope of the Department's investigation, (2) the preliminary procedural schedule set by the Department and (3) the process by which any person may participate in this proceeding.

Pursuant to 220 CMR 1.03(1), any person who desires to participate in this proceeding shall file a written petition for leave to participate by June 30, 1994.

The Department shall serve a copy of this notice upon all local distribution companies in the Commonwealth and all parties to Bay State Gas Company, D.P.U. 92-150 (1993).
