- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council joins the voices of Pope John Paul II and our brothers and sisters of Polish heritage in Cambridge to decry this outrage of tyranny; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge provide containers at all branch libraries and fire stations for the collecting of food and clothing to be sent to the people of Poland.
