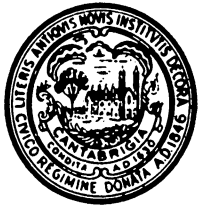
Thank you for your recent letter requesting cleanup of our property at the corner of Garfield Avenue and Massachusetts Avenue.
