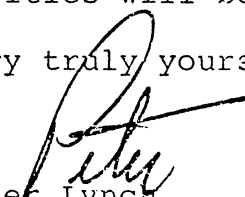
Dear Richard:

The request by the Cambridge City Council that a clock be installed at the Harvard/Brattle Station has been taken under advisement by the MBTA. While a clock at that location might prove to be very useful, the source of the clock and the means of installation need to be pursued.

One suggestion, which was made to this office, was that the historic clock, which has been temporarily removed from the sidewalk near the Harvard Coop, be relocated with the owners consent to the Harvard/Brattle Station, for the duration of subway construction. Another possibility is that an advertiser might install a clock as is the case at several other MBTA stations.

Each of these and other possibilities will be pursued.

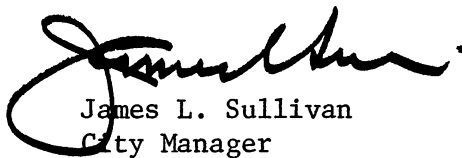
