Garden Street between point of connection with existing trackless trolley line at Waterhouse Street and point of connection with existing trackless trolley line at Massachusetts Avenue.

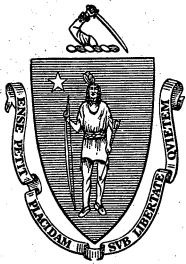

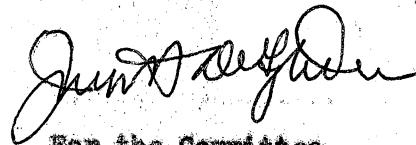
