- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Reverend LeRoy Attles, Pastor of Saint Paul A.M.E. Church will soon celebrate the Twentieth Anniversary of his ordination into the African Methodist Episcopal Ministry; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Attles was ordained in April of 1962, at which time he was assigned to his first Pastorate at the Bethel A.M.E. Church, in Patterson, New Jersey and has subsequently held pastorates in South Boundbrook, Passaic and Orange, New Jersey, prior to his arrival as Pastor of Saint Paul A.M.E. Church here in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: During his first year at Saint Paul's, Reverend Attles initiated a fund drive called "105 Steps to Faith", by which a long-standing mortgage of \$56,000 was discharged, a project that would never have been accomplished without Reverend Attles leadership and the strong support of his congregation; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to Reverend LeRoy Attles on the happy and blessed occasion of his Twentieth Anniversary in the African Methodist Episcopal Ministry; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Reverend Attles on behalf of the entire City Council.
