- WHEREAS: Charles, a native of Quissett, Cape Cod and a graduate of Principia School in St. Louis, Missouri served his country during World War II as a member of the United States Navy; and
- WHEREAS: Once he was honorably discharged he worked in the underwater explosives research laboratory at the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution, prior to entering the management of family-owned properties, an enterprise in which he remained active until his death in Loire Valley, France on Sunday, October 8, 1989; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Charles' sister, Patricia B. Butcher of Concord, and the entire Blevins family at this unfortunate loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
