In Board of Aldermen, May 7, 1873

The Committee on Roads & Bridges to which was referred the petition of Calvin Dimick and others for laying out and acceptance of Line St.

Reports, recommending, That when the abutters on the westerly side of said street will agree to allow the whole of the land necessary to make the street 40 ft. wide, to be taken from their side, and to give one half of said quantity; and the abutters on the easterly side agree to pay the value of the other half of said quantity, and any other damage awarded, then the City proceed to lay out and accept said street as a public way.

The City Engineer to join with the City Engineer of Somerville in establishing lines and grade, and furnishing plans for both cities.
