On April 8, 1975 at 9:30 AM, in response to a request from the Cambridge Conservation Commission, the MDC will dig an observation trench along the Charles River where the Sycamore trees are closest to the river.

The purpose will be to determine information about the root configuration of the Sycamore trees in preparation for a Wetlands Protection Act (General Law Ch. 131, sec. 40) public hearing to determine the potential impact on the trees of the MDC's proposed North Charles Relief Sewer extension.
