WHEREAS: On July 15, 2001 a serious explosion blasted through the fourth floor of a Bent Street building in which renovations had just been completed and which had not yet been occupied; and

WHEREAS: Thanks to quick and coordinated action by Cambridge police officers, firefighters and emergency response workers, the cleaning staff and other persons in the building were quickly evacuated and damage to the building was minimized; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record thanking the Cambridge Fire, Police and Emergency Response for their quick action to the explosion on Bent Street; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward this resolution to the Cambridge Fire Chief, the Cambridge Police Commissioner and Professional Ambulance Services on behalf of the entire City Council.
