I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$30,897.00 into the Grant fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$4,920.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$25,977.00) from the U.S. Department of Housing of Urban Development. The Cambridge Housing Authority and the Department of Human Services have entered into an agreement to provide residents of Cambridge public housing slots in the Community Schools Summer Camp programs, after-school enrichment program, one-day and two-day recreational trips and mens and women's basketball leagues. These funds will be used to cover part time youth staff to supervise trips and recreational activities and costs associated with these programs.
