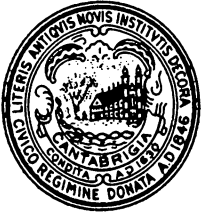

SUBJECT: City Council Order #15, dated April 1, 1985

During the month of May, 1985, the Cambridge Police Department issued 34 citations to trucks for violations against M.G.L. c85, s2, Regulations and By-Laws Relative to Ways and Bridges, Direction Signs, etc. The posted signs prohibit commercial vehicles over 2½ tons from specified streets between the hours of 7:00p - 7:00a and weekend days in accordance with Traffic Regulation #74-18 enacted on July 18, 1974.
