- WHEREAS: Captain Byrne was first appointed to the department on February 14, 1943 at which time he was assigned to the Rescue Company, and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Byrne was transferred to Engine Four on March 30, 1947 and remained at that assignment until January 2, 1955 when he was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant and transferred to Ladder Three, and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Byrne was promoted again on July 22, 1973 to the rank of Captain and transferred to Engine Six serving in that assignment until October 21, 1973 at which time he transferred to Ladder Four his present assignment, and
- WHEREAS: Captain Byrne is well known in the department for his dedication to duty and his leadership qualities, and
- WHEREAS: He will be greatly missed by his many friends and colleagues, both in and out of the department, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude and appreciation to Captain Thomas A. Byrne as he prepares to retire from active duty after thirty-seven years of fire service and to further extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Captain Byrne on behalf of the entire City Council.
