Engine Co. #3 responded for a water problem. Water main broken in the street flooding completely to the first floor the cellar at #521, 523, 525, 527 & 543 Cambridge Street. The water department had responded, left and returned at 7:45 to shut down the mains. Notified Fire Alarm to send the Electric Light Company to the scene to shut down all electric service, some completely under water. Called for the fire fighting unit to remove the submersible pumps. Engine 3 at the scene throughout due to the possibility of an electrical fire from the flooding. All owners notified of an electrical fire from the flooding. All owners notified to remain to heating & electrical equipment could start. Cambridge Fire Co. at scene for gas powered equipment.
