To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Massachusetts Housing and Shelter Alliance through the Massachusetts Department of Transitional Assistance for \$78,439 to the Grant Fund Human Services Salaries and Wages account (\$78,011) and Other Ordinary Maintenance account (\$428). Funds will be used to support the Carey Men's Transitional Program operated by the Multi-Service Center. This program assists homeless men to end their homelessness by providing transitional housing at the Cambridge YMCA, as well as counseling and case management services. Program participants are assisted through a network of prevention, mental health services, legal services, money management, employment, adult education and housing search services. The grant supports 1.5 FTE caseworker positions and benefits.
