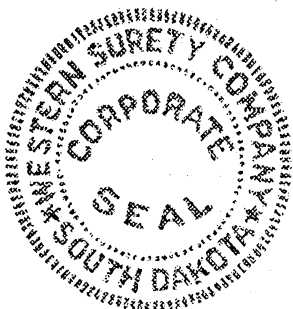

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

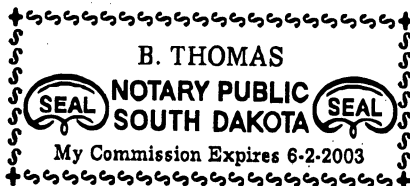

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING SIGN PERMITS

- 1) APPLICATION MAY BE SECURED AT THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE.
- 2) PRESENT TO INSPECTIONAL SERVICES DEPT.
 - A. APPLICATION FOR SIGN,
 - B. SKETCH OR DRAWING,
 - C. APPROVAL OF ABUTTERS.
- 3) PRESENT APPLICATION TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPT. FOR DESIGN REVIEW APPROVAL, IF APPLICABLE (i.e. awning or canopy with reading matter on said canopy or awning.)
- 4) AFTER APPROVAL FROM INSPECTIONAL SERVICES DEPT. AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPT. FILE THE APPLICATION WITH THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE CITY COUNCIL.
- 5) WHEN THE PETITION IS SUBMITTED A PERIOD OF SEVEN TO FOURTEEN DAYS WILL ELAPSE BEFORE THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE PETITIONER.
- 6) WHEN THE CITY COUNCIL HAS APPROVED THE PETITION, NOTICE OF ITS APPROVAL WILL BE SENT IMMEDIATELY TO THE PETITIONER TOGETHER WITH AN UNEXECUTED BOND FORM.
- 7) PETITIONER WILL HAVE THE BOND FORM EXECUTED BY A SURETY COMPANY AND WILL RETURN THE SAME TO CLERK'S OFFICE. AT THAT TIME PETITIONER WILL RECEIVE A COPY OF THE COUNCIL ORDER APPROVING THE SIGN AND STATING THAT A BOND IS ON FILE WITH THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE.
- 8) THAT COUNCIL ORDER MUST BE PRESENTED BY THE PETITIONER TO THE INSPECTIONAL SERVICES DEPT., LOCATED AT 831 MASS. AVENUE.
- 9) INSPECTIONAL SERVICES WILL THEN ISSUE A PERMIT TO ERECT YOUR (SIGN, CANOPY, AWNING, MARQUIS, BARBER POLE, OR FLAG POLE.)
- 10) THE FINAL STEP IS GO TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, LOCATED AT 147 HAMPSHIRE STREET, TO OBTAIN A PERMIT TO OBSTRUCT THE SIDEWALK .
