

He shall attend all meetings of the Board, and keep a record of their proceedings. He shall take charge of all books, maps, plans, and documents appertaining to the Water Works. It shall be his duty to keep books, wherein shall be entered a full and accurate statement of all receipts and expenditures; receive all bills and accounts against the city which are presented on or before the fifteenth day of each month, examine them in detail, and, when approved by the committee, or party who contracted them, enter them in the proper books, and present them with a schedule thereof to the Board for approval. He shall, under the direction of the President, receive all applications for service-pipes, and for water to be let on or shut off, and keep a record of the same, specifying the time and reasons therefor; cause the water to be let on when the rates are paid, and, in any case of non-payment, cause it at once to be shut off; report to the Board monthly the number of fines, cases of water shut off, and of those let on; also, all charges therefor, and for any other work performed under his direction; and shall perform such further services as may be required by the President or the Board.

SEC. 6. The amount of any pay-roll for work done on the Water Works, or for services rendered to the Water Board, which shall have been approved by the Water Board and the Committee on Accounts, and examined by the Auditor, may be drawn from the City Treasury on an order from the President of the Board.

SEC. 7. The Cambridge Water Board shall, with their annual report to the City Council, at the same time transmit to the City Council the Report of the Water Registrar, including a detailed statement of all expenditures of the Water Board for the year ending November thirtieth; a statement of the number of water-takers; the number of cases in which the water has been cut off; the number and amount of abatements; and such other matters as he or the Board may deem expedient.

SEC. 8. So much of the Ordinance to which this is in addition, as is inconsistent herewith, is hereby repealed.

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ORDINANCE

In addition to "An Ordinance providing for the Care and Management of the Cambridge Water Works."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

SEC. 1. The President of the Cambridge Water Board shall be elected by the Board, and shall be one of the five persons mentioned in the first section of the Ordinance to which this Ordinance is in addition.

SEC. 2. The Superintendent of the Water Works shall take charge of the aqueduct, lands, reservoirs, and other works and property connected with the Water Works, as the Water Board may from time to time direct; and he shall perform all such services in relation thereto as may be required of him by said Board, and shall annually, during the first week of December, present to the Water Board a report of the general condition of the works.

SEC. 3. The Water Board shall elect a Water Registrar, who shall hold office during the pleasure of the Board, and shall receive such compensation as the Board may determine.

SEC. 4. The Water Registrar shall perform all such services as are prescribed for the Superintendent in the Ordinance to which
