Spiegelman, Assistant City Manager for Community Development relative to the purchase and sale of land on Cogswell Avenue to Homeowner's Rehab, Inc. for the purpose of rehabilitating a house for the lower-income family under the Work Equity Program; and

Homeowner's Rehab, Inc. hereby request the City of Cambridge to purchase a parcel of land, known as 51 Cogswell Avenue, from the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority for the purpose of reselling the land to Homeowners Rehab, Inc. in its Work Equity Program; said parcel is on a plan entitled "Proposed Revisions To A Public Way", dated September 13, 1983 and prepared by E.H. Fagerstrom, Registered Surveyor, containing approximately 477 square feet more or less; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That due notice be given to the owners abutting on said public way, and all other persons interested, and in the manner prescribed by law, that this City Council intends to hold a public hearing on Monday, June 25, 1984 at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, Cambridge, Massachusetts on the proposed purchase and sale of land at 51 Cogswell Avenue and any objections may be heard at this time.

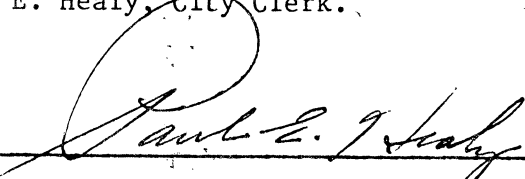
COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

- WHEREAS: Alonzo attended local public schools, graduating from Cambridge High and Latin, and later went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree from Lincoln University and a Master's Degree from the University of Pennsylvania, and upon completing his academic career, began working in the social service area; and
- WHEREAS: Alonzo had long been active in the Cambridge community, serving at one time as Chairman of the Cambridge Civic Unity Committee, Treasurer of St. Bartholomew's Church, and a Board Member of the Cambridge-Somerville Catholic Charitable Bureau and the Visiting Nurses Association; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Celestine Hilliard and to the entire Hilliard family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
