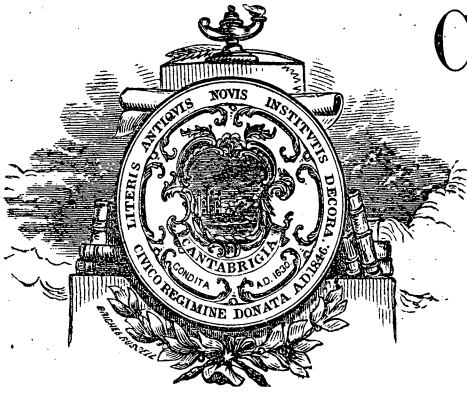




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

November 15th 1871

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Felton Street between Broadway and Cambridge Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

Forty feet in width between

Broadway and Cambridge Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *J. G. Chase* City Engineer & dated *November 15th 1871*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
