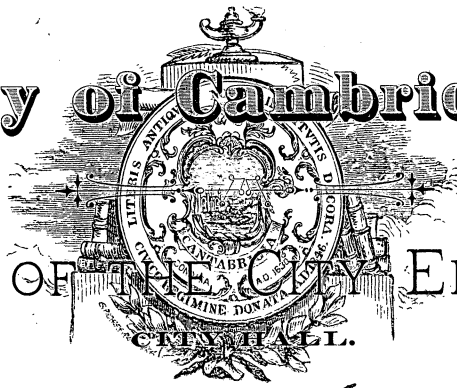

To the Committee on New Bridge to Boston Gentlemen.

The City Engineer submits the accompanying plans for a proposed new bridge across Charles River, between West Chester Park extended in Boston, and Front Street extended in Cambridge, together with the following Estimates.

1 st	For a bridge	^{70 ft} seventy feet wide	with a	^{50 ft} fifty foot draw	\$416,000.
2 nd	" " " "	^{80 ft} Eighty " " " "	"	^{70 ft} seventy " " "	\$475,428.
3 rd	" " " "	one hundred " " " "	"	^{80 ft} Eighty " " "	\$594,285.

The above work has been done in connection with the City Engineer of Boston, separate plans being presented by each Engineer. The Estimates have been compared and agreed upon as above given.
