COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: While applauding the new playground on the Cambridge Common as "a wonderful playground with good challenges for kids," several parents have expressed much concern about what they see as a very serious danger with the large wooden structure on which there is a moveable ramp made of wooden slats connected together. It appears that the slats are too close together with the result that, as the ramp moves, it would be very easy for a child's finger, hand or toes to be crushed; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the appropriate departmental personnel to examine this structure as soon as possible, to determine if there is a design flaw or flaw in construction, and take whatever immediate remedial steps are necessary to assure the total safety of the children who use it with much frequency during this particular time of year; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on this concern within one week.
