That, on the petition of Prospect Apartments Inc., that they be granted permission to connect their properties on Harvard Street, with the common sewer, provided that they first pay into the City Treasury the usual ^{SEWER} assessment amounting in this case to Two hundred eighty-nine dollars and ninety cents (\$289.90). And it is further

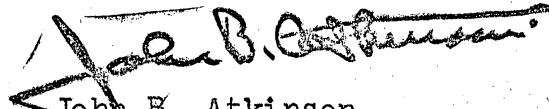
