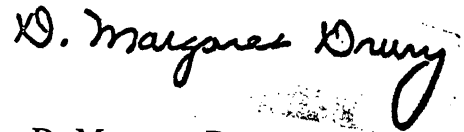
WHEREAS: Ellen will be sorely missed by all she touched and loved; now therefore be it
