ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to notify the Postmaster of this roadway name and location.

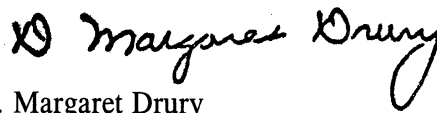
