In City Council,
April 5, 1971.

ORDERED:-

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Bruce G. Thayer, Executive Director, International Student Association of Greater Boston to occupy a portion of Garden Street, between Chauncy and Walker Streets, for a distance of 125 feet from the intersection of Chauncy and Garden Streets during the period April 30 to May 2, 1971, from 6:00 P. M. to 10:00 A.M. on April 30th during which time two lanes of traffic will be kept open; on May 1st 125 feet of Garden Street will be completely closed from 10:00 A.M. until 2:00 A.M. on May 2nd.

The above permit is granted subject to the petitioner -

- (a) Constructing appropriate safeguards for the safety of the people at the Fun Fair
- (b) Obtaining permission from the Director of Traffic and Parking which permission will provide for the placing of appropriate traffic control signs during the period of the occupancy of the public way.
- (c) Obtaining permission from the Chief of the Police Department and the Chief of the Fire Department to insure the safety of all persons and property in the immediate locale.

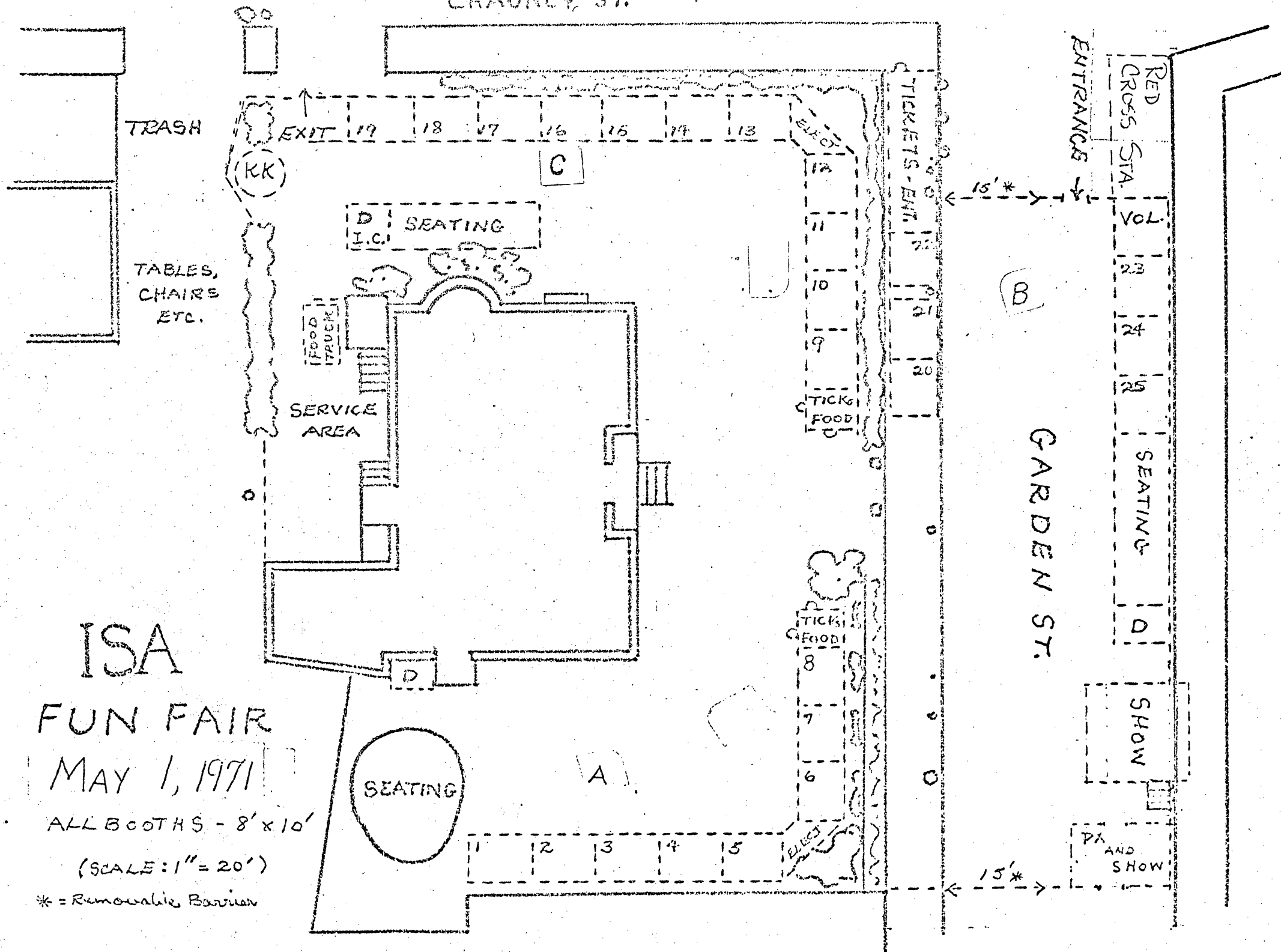

After speaking with Mr. Thomas Mahoney, I submit this request to the City Council for a license to obstruct the street.

The International Student Association's annual Fun Fair is planned for Saturday, May First, this year. For the past many years we have used a part of Garden Street in front of the Center. Enclosed is our lay-out plan for this year's Fair. It is substantially the same as that of last year. We have received the necessary permits from the Traffic and Parking Department to limit traffic to two lanes from 6:00 p.m., April 30th, to 10:00 a.m., May 1st, and to close about 125 feet of the street completely from 10:00 a.m., May 1st, until 2:00 a.m., May 2nd. During this time, we would like permission to erect the following in the area:

ticket booths
a raised platform
a few special purpose booths
a barrier surrounding the area -- this has movable sections 15' long to conform with Fire Department regulations.

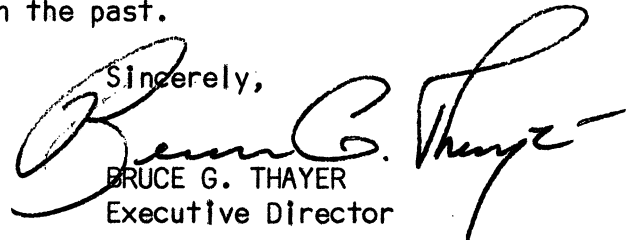
