- WHEREAS: IPPNW seeks to prevent all wars, to promote non-violent conflict resolution, and to minimize the effects of war and preparations for war on health, development, and the environment; and
- WHEREAS: IPPNW is the only international medical organization dedicated to the abolition of all nuclear weapons; and
- WHEREAS: IPPNW is touring the country presenting local communities with checks valuing the amount of money that communities are losing to the cost of the war in Iraq; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record supporting IPPNW and the work they do around the research, education, and advocacy relevant to the prevention of nuclear war; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution onto IPPNW on behalf of the entire City Council.
