Pursuant to a City Council order regarding repairing of motor vehicles at above captioned property, the following has transpired.

The original inspection was made on October 29, 1986, with compliance date set for November 7, 1986. On reinspection, it was noted that one unregistered car was removed. Also, neighbors were still complaining about the repair work.

Show cause hearing set for November 25, 1986. At the show cause hearing, the son of the owner claims he works only on his own car; and his father's cab.

June 15, 1987, another complaint was received about repairs being made on car's in yard. A citation was written and sent to the owner. Compliance date was June 30, 1987.

June 19, 1987, Patty Michaels Realtor was contacted and informed this office the papers were being passed today. They also allege the tenant is to vacate the property by the end of the day.
