ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Board of Assessors to conduct a survey in Wards 7, 8 and 9 to determine what the financial impact will be on property in this area once 100% valuation is implemented; and be it further

ORDERED: Once said survey is completed and in fact indicates that property taxes in Wards 7, 8 and 9 will double or triple, that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Board of Assessors to officially notify the property owners in these wards so they may plan their strategy and adequately prepare for the future payments of property taxes.
