

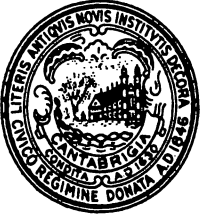

To the Honorable, the City Council:

This is to request an appropriation of \$25,000 to the Finance Department (Assessing) Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. When the FY 85 Assessing Budget was prepared the City did not intend to trend property values. However, shortly thereafter, it was determined that not only was the City in a position to trend values but that, from a tax equity standpoint, it was the fair thing to do.

Work on trending property values was begun in July. Residential property was trended by City staff while commercial property was trended with the assistance of the real estate appraisal firm, R. M. Bradley. Due to this change in plan, the additional funds are needed to pay the increase workload of R. M. Bradley caused by trending City values as of January 1, 1984.

Passage of the enclosed order is recommended.
