To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$7,400.00 from the Health Department Salary & Wages Account to the Health Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The funds will be used to purchase new 486-based personal computers. New computer equipment will allow this department to more effectively meet state reporting requirements related to vaccine distribution and communicable disease surveillance. With such equipment we will be ready for anticipated changes in state reporting, including electronic reporting. New equipment will also permit Public Health Nursing to do effective case management to active TB patients, as well as the capability to effectively case manage outbreaks of other communicable diseases should such events occur. In addition, the importance of health status indicators and other data has become increasingly important for strategic planning and resource development, and new equipment would allow us fast and easy access to a variety of databases and other sources available from state and federal government, as well as the ability to analyze and utilize such data.
