I just discovered that you all have email these days, which give me a great opportunity to be in touch and see if I can get something moving on the self-defense for girls programming...

First of all-

A brief report: Just completed a workshop in self-def for women and children that was sponsored by the womens' Commission in conjunction w/

womens' Health Day. There were roughly 80 participants, including 20 children. The workshop was a fabulous success.

This workshop generated tremendous interest/motivation to provide further

programs for girls, and in light of recent abduction attempts and the killings in AK, interest is very high and parents want to be proactive.

I have been consulting with dept of Human Services regarding a program for

teens in the Youth Centers, but we are moving very slowly, and it is doubtfull that anything will be scheduled until the fall.

I know you are each very supportive of the Girls LEAP program, and I wonder

if you can suggest any sources of funding that I might not have thought of so that we could offer a young girls program this spring, most likely through the Community Schools. Are there any small grants or monies that

we could combine to put something together for this year? It seems a tremendous shame to not be able to continue to move forward at this time.

I look forward to hearing from you all and hope that you don't mind being

connected in this "cyberspace" way.

WHEREAS: There has been some discussion of offering this program through the Youth Centers, but probably not until next fall at the earliest; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Assistant City Manager for Human Services and the Superintendent of Schools with the view of looking into whether there are any grants or other sources of funds that could be used to make these programs available to Cambridge women and children as soon as possible, with a report back to the City Council.
