This City Council has received numerous complaints relative to the large number of students from Cambridge High and Latin and Rindge Technical School out of class and hanging on the street corners, lawns and front and rear porches of people's homes in and around the school area, and

WHEREAS:

Many residents of this area have been the recipients of wide scale vandalism to their homes and cars, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to immediately arrange a meeting with the Superintendent of Schools and the Chief of Police in order that they can establish and initiate a comprehensive program by which all the high school students will be returned to the classroom, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That this program pay particular attention to the streets immediately around the high schools including: Trowbridge, Ware, Irving, Dana and Ellery Streets and Roberts Road, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council within two weeks the action taken by him pursuant to this order.
