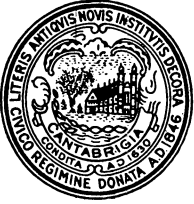


Dear Sir:

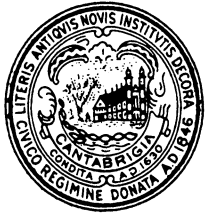
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Joseph Thomas in which there was a judgment of \$79.15.
