In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, - Oct. 15. 1862.

WHEREAS; in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that *Brighton Street, in Ward No. One, between Brattle Square and Mount Auburn Street* should be widened so as to conform to the red lines shown on the Plan of said Street, in the City Clerk's Office, Street Plans, Vol. 2, Page 70. it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to *William Rees, Martha P. Gregory, Susan Maria Porter, the heirs of Joseph Patten, and all other persons or persons whose land would be taken by such widening*

that this Board intends to *widen* the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of *their* land and laying out the same as a public street—and that *Friday, the twenty-fourth day of October current, at 8 o'clock, A. M.,* is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto, *for which purpose the Board will be in session at the corner of Brattle & Brighton Streets.*
