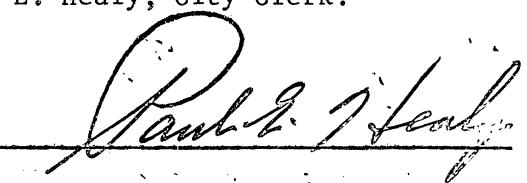

- WHEREAS: Owen first entered the employ of the City in 1938 as a Budget Examiner working in that capacity until being promoted to Director of Budget and Personnel in 1948, a position he held until his retirement in 1972, completing thirty-four years of municipal service; and
- WHEREAS: While serving as head of Personnel he also served as Secretary to the Cambridge Hospital Board of Trustees for many years, providing guidance to that Board at a time when health care delivery was reaching a new era; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout Mr. McCall's long public tenure he served each City Manager and City Council with an equal level of dedication and commitment; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Helen McCall and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. McCall on behalf of the entire City Council.
