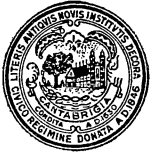

COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Community Development Department to prepare an official summary of the proposed request for a Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation District, outlining the proposal to all area property owners, residents and voters; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Community Development Department conduct a postcard survey, together with return postage, for distribution to the area property owners, residents and voters requesting them to indicate whether or not they are in favor of the proposed request for establishing a Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation District as submitted by the Study Commission, and further requesting them to list any alternatives they may seek for the community and to return these postcards to the Community Development Department; and be it further
- ORDERED: That when all the results of the survey have been completed, the City Manager direct the Community Development Department to forward the results of the survey to this City Council with appropriate recommendations, for their consideration at a future meeting.
