This letter is in reference to a recent destructive flood in the cellar of 26 Sherman Street, Cambridge.

This flood was a direct result of a faulty drain pipe in the street causing water to back up into this cellar and the cellars of several houses adjacent to this property.

Please be informed much damage has been done by this water.

This flood occurred on the morning of February 2nd, 1976. We have contacted our Insurance Co. and have been informed that we are not covered by water damage.

We have been informed by the inspector's of the Cambridge Water Dept. that this problem could occur again in the near future until this drain problem is corrected.

Please make note of this letter and we would appreciate a return letter from you on this matter as soon as possible
