The Committee on Roads and Bridges of this board, which was authorized under an order adopted June 2<sup>d</sup>. to cause the removal of certain trees named in said order, - and to which were referred sundry petitions praying for the removal of trees, - moved hereunto

Resolved,

That inasmuch as by a Legislative Act, approved April 3. 1885, it is provided that a public notice and hearing shall be given before the removal of any trees standing in the public highways, the order aforesaid is of no effect.
