- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the City Council that because of the current fiscal crisis in the Commonwealth Governor Michael S. Dukakis has ordered the closing of the Chelsea Soldier's Home, a facility used to house former veterans many of whom are in the twilight of their lives; and
- WHEREAS: The closing of this facility not only endangers the future of these veterans but forces them to seek alternative housing or to become street people; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record opposed to the Governor's action and urge him to reconsider his decision; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Governor Michael S. Dukakis on behalf of the City Council.
