

D2, Food and Ice: This item is essential for certain but not all library functions. The Library Staff continues to make the major contribution, however, the Cambridge Public Library must help also. These are for foods served at many library functions in all of our libraries.

B8, Light and Power: To meet current obligations.

B13, Communication: Tighter measures have been instituted to control the Communication budget. However, in spite of the transfer request, the library will not have expended more than one hundred dollars per month for toll charges. This includes five (5) branch libraries and the Main Library with four lines and over fifteen (15) extensions.


