- WHEREAS: Paul, a life long Cantabrigian, attended local schools and upon graduation from Boston College, entered the United States Army, served in World Warr II and rose to the rank of Captain, serving directly under General Douglas MacArthur; and
- WHEREAS: Once Paul received his honorable discharge, he joined the Cambridge School Department as a teacher in 1950 and through the years and after many classroom assignments was appointed to the position from which he will retire; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere gratitude in recognition of Paul Dawson's thirty-three years of service to the Cambridge School Department; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Dawson on behalf of the entire City Council.

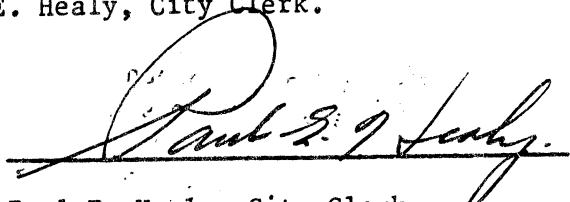
