To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$25,000 in the Grant Fund from the Governor's Alliance Against Drugs to the Executive Department Salary and Wages Account (\$21,216) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$3,784). These funds will be used by the Positive Edge Program to undertake a violence prevention peer leadership program.

"Leaders for Positive Edge," a peer leadership program designed to curb youth violence, directs its attention toward at-risk youth. This program will assist older youth in impacting the choices of younger youth, and in increasing their awareness of the need for change in the community. Services will be delivered in a variety of settings including the City youth centers, religious institutions, housing complexes, and other locations where youth usually gather including parks and streets.

This program will be run by a half-time youth leadership coordinator, and three volunteer coordinators who will each be responsible for recruitment and related activities for one-third of the City. City youth will be trained to be volunteer trainers for other youth around violence prevention.
