CENSUS 2000: COMPLETE YOUR FORM TODAY!!

Cambridge City Hall will serve as a Questionnaire Assistance Center for Census 2000 on Thursdays, from 2-5 p.m., through April 13. Please complete and return your form today and encourage others to do so. Census figures help determine various things, from the amount of federal dollars allocated to cities for community-based programs and services to the correct apportionment of congressional seats.

Many people may fail to respond to Census questionnaires and even to enumerators at their doors because of language and literacy barriers, fear of the government, misunderstanding of purpose and importance of participating, reluctance to divulge personal information, etc. They may not know that information they provide to the Census is absolutely confidential or they may think they already completed the Census when they answered the City's annual Census questionnaire recently. Census 2000 is a separate effort and it is important that you complete both forms. Otherwise, you could lose out on some valuable public benefits and services. Remember, this is your future, don't leave it blank.
