Dyke Street -
from DeWolf St. to the Dock
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty five feet*
in width between *DeWolf St. and the Dock*

included between the

red lines as shown on a plan drawn by
J. G. Chase City Engineer

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *And*
that thirty days be allowed for the removal
of all obstructions standing thereon,
