Peter G. Piro, 69

Former Somerville alderman

A funeral Mass will be said today for Peter G. Piro of Somerville, former president of the Somerville Board of Alderman, who died Friday at Whidden Memorial Hospital in Everett. He was 69.

Mr. Piro was born in Somerville and attended Somerville schools. He served in the Air Force during the Korean War.

He owned and operated Piro Printing of Somerville, a family business founded by his father.

Mr. Piro was also chairman of the Somerville School Committee. He sponsored many sporting and educational activities in that city and was active in many fraternal and civic groups. He was also known for his contributions to finding a cure for spina bifida.

He leaves his wife, Penny (Mullin); a son, Marc of Wilmington; three daughters, Janice Zoccola of Maynard, Anna Marie Catino of Wilmington, and Donna Andon of Malden; a sister, Carmella Rancatore of Billerica; two brothers, Vincent J. of Winchester and Joseph of Somerville, and six grandchildren.

A funeral Mass will be said at 10 a.m. in St. Ann's Church in Somerville. Cremation will follow in Woodlawn Cemetery in Everett.
