ORDERED: That the Financial Officer of the City of Cambridge be directed by the City Manager to come up with the real per pupil cost, taking into consideration such items as Blue Cross, pensions, insurance and any other items that might be budgeted in the City Manager's budget rather than the School Department's budget, and to include debt and interest in any school construction; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to send a team of three (3) city budget analysts to the School Department in order that they can carefully scrutinize the School Department budget to determine whether or not they really need the requested additional \$1,000,000 and also to determine why this deficit spending was allowed to happen; specifically why were 40 new employees hired since July 1, 1979; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to submit the response of the budget analysts within three weeks.

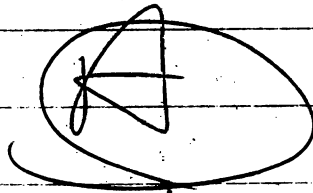
