In September, 1970; I began as a staff attorney at the Newark-Essex Joint Law Reform Project of which I later became Deputy Director. The Project is a legal services project set up to represent community groups and to address itself to legal and political issues which affect large numbers of Newark's urban poor. While dealing with virtually every type of legal issue while at the project, I specialized in two areas: housing and labor relations.

In labor relations, I participated in the drafting of the Newark Plan, based upon the Philadelphia experience. This is a plan to facilitate the entry of minorities into the construction trades. The plan has been adopted by virtually every major building project in Newark. Sponsors of the plan include the Port Authority, Rutgers, and the Newark Board of Education. To implement the Plan, we established the Newark Construction Trades Training Corporation which gives craft and remedial education to trainees. Over 200 trainees on jobs today receive in-shop skill training and remedial help on a day per week basis. I have dealt with numerous federal, state, and local agencies in furtherance of the plans. Various construction trade unions have been brought into the training program including operating engineers, iron workers, and painters. These unions take responsibility for the on-site training at the particular construction project and take charge of the off-site training of the individual at the Newark Construction Training Corporation. I am presently serving as counsel to the training corporation. I published an article describing the plan. See 23 Catholic University Law Review, p. 443.
