WHEREAS: Recently this City witnessed a tragic accident and explosion of a fuel truck which caused the death of the truck driver; and

WHEREAS: This accident could have caused many more deaths and severe injuries if this had occurred on a weekday or during a particularly busy time during a weekend; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to review the feasibility of re-routing all fuel truck traffic to the outer perimeters of our City in an effort to deter this hazardous traffic through our main streets and ways; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to submit this report from the Traffic Director to this Council as soon as possible.
