Dear Council Member Triantafillou,

As a member of the Cambridge City Council, we are sure you share our commitment to support victims of domestic violence and to aid in the prevention of such violence.

On Friday, February 13 at 5 p.m., *CambridgeSide Galleria* and the *Massachusetts Coalition of Battered Women Service Groups* will host a candlelight vigil to recognize the twenty-one victims who died as a result of domestic violence in Massachusetts in 1997. A domestic violence survivor will light the first of 21 candles in their memory. Each candle will be lit, one by one, to be floated in the lagoon while opponents of such tragedies illuminate their own candles in a minute of silence. These survivors and supporters aim to spread the message that remembering is not enough -- prevention is the only thing that works. **We ask that you join us in the ceremony to show your support.**

As you probably know, *CambridgeSide Galleria* has been very active in recent months, working with Nancy Ryan of the Cambridge Commission on the Status of Women and other organizations to support women's issues.

The Massachusetts Coalition of Battered Women Service Groups represents 32 shelters for battered women throughout the state. *CambridgeSide Galleria* (a *WellsPark Group* mall), is launching the most comprehensive program of its kind against domestic violence in the country.

This public memorial service will be just the beginning of a statewide partnership between *WellsPark Group* malls in Massachusetts and the Coalition. The partnership will include training programs for mall employees, in-mall fundraising mechanisms for shelters, mall support of Jane Doe Safety Fund events and products and many other mall-based programs. (*WellsPark Group* malls include Arsenal Mall, *CambridgeSide Galleria*, Square One Mall, and others.)

Again, we hope you will join us on Friday, February 13 to show your support. The candlelight vigil will be held at *CambridgeSide Galleria's* lagoon. Please RSVP to Klee Helander at 617-621-8668.
