It has recently been brought to my attention that there are serious traffic violation problems in East Cambridge. In particular, trucks are said to be violating the truck ban on Gore Street; also, speeding cars and cars pulling into the wrong lane to avoid rush hour traffic have become a serious safety threat on Third Street. Therefore, I am writing to instruct you to increase traffic enforcement throughout East Cambridge, paying particular attention to Third Street and Gore Street; and to maintain that level of enforcement as long as necessary.
